### **Cafayate, Argentina, Red;**

**Altimus, Michel Torino Cafayate 2011** 47

61% Malbec, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon, 14% Cabernet Franc. This is made high in the Andes and is MASSIVE. Without cheese or red meat, the fruit, oak and alcohol may overwhelm the delicate drinker.

### **Burgundy, France, White;**

**Rully, Domaine La Tour de Brully, Clos des Mollepierres 2013** 40

Vibrant and full yellow in colour with a very expressive, fruit driven, typically Burgundian note on the nose. Relatively forward and rich in texture but with a vibrant backbone of acidity keeping everything in check.
