

# Coming for drinks... Updated 10<sup>th</sup> July

We have plenty of space for casual drinking. However, this is on a first come first served basis.

For a while, the idea of a casual standing drink will be difficult given the constraints and rules the hospitality industry have to adopt.

All we ask is that you are respectful of the systems and policies that we have to manage.

As with ALL our communication at present, the best way to enjoy a drink is to have it with a meal that you've booked.

1. We have river benches and a beer tent for walk in seated drinks, the bar area is now set up for distanced queueing and drinks collection, the beer tent is the wet weather contingency
2. We are not having any standing drinking. All drinks can be consumed at seated tables of a maximum of 6 guests
3. We have no extra space for drinkers inside if it rains and all inside tables are taken, the beer tent has a limited capacity
4. If you are drinking in your social bubble, we advise that you arrive together to avoid queueing or confusion with multiple people trying to join existing tables
5. We ask that your movement at the restaurant is restricted to seating, collecting drinks and loo breaks
6. All tables are on a first come first served basis, and we ask that you leave them in the positions they are laid out in
7. We expect to allow people to stay at their table for a maximum 3 hour period, after which we may need you to vacate the table for other guests arrival
8. The terrace and beer tent opens first, when they are full we open the island, every area has to be monitored hence why we cannot open all at once

We hope that this clears up some of the questions that you have.
